AT-HOME PRINTING TIPS



1. In the print menu, choose the below settings (location may vary depending on your software) and set to print in full color.

- After opening in Adobe Acrobat (recommended program for PDFs), use the Print as Image setting found by clicking on the Advanced button to ensure all images on the page will print.

- Print only a few pages to ensure that double-sided printing is best aligned for cutting purposes.
- If you have trouble viewing the files, make sure you are using the latest version of your PDF viewer or use a different program. Many people have success using the most updated version of Adobe Acrobat Reader to open and print files.
- Explore your printer settings or your PDF program's help section for additional guidance.
- Paperweight and paper brightness affect color. Typical copy paper is 20 lb and 92 bright. For more vivid color printing, choose copy paper closer to 32 lb and 98 bright. (24-lb and 28-lb paper also produce quality color copies.)
