### ONE MORE OR ONE LESS \* ONE PLAYER

SETUP: Place the owl and egg cards faceup on the table. Shuffle the remaining cards and place the deck on the table with the problems facing up.

HOW TO PLAY: Answer the subtraction problem on top of the deck. If the answer is 1 more or 1 less than a number on an owl card, you win that owl card. If the answer is 0, you win an egg card. You may only win one owl or egg card each turn. If you win an owl or egg card, place the card in your winnings pile, then place the answered card facedown in a discard pile. Start your next turn by answering the problem on the next card.

HOW TO WIN: The game is over when there are no more owl cards left. If you have at least one egg card at the end of the game, you win!

## ONE MORE OR ONE LESS \* TWO PLAYERS

SETUP: Place the owl and egg cards faceup on the table so both players can see them. Shuffle the remaining cards and deal them evenly between

### ALL FOUR OWLS \* ONE PLAYER

SETUP: Place 4 owl cards facedown on the table. Set the unused owl card and both egg cards to the side. (You won't need them for this game.) Shuffle the remaining cards and place the deck on the table with the problems facing up.

HOW TO PLAY: Answer aloud the subtraction problem on top of your stack. If the answer is 4, place it on top of an owl card. If the answer is not 4, place it in the discard pile, then answer the problem on the next card.

HOW TO WIN: When all 4 owls are covered, you win.
